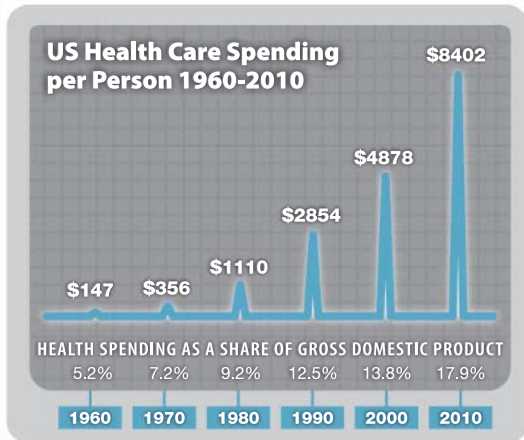
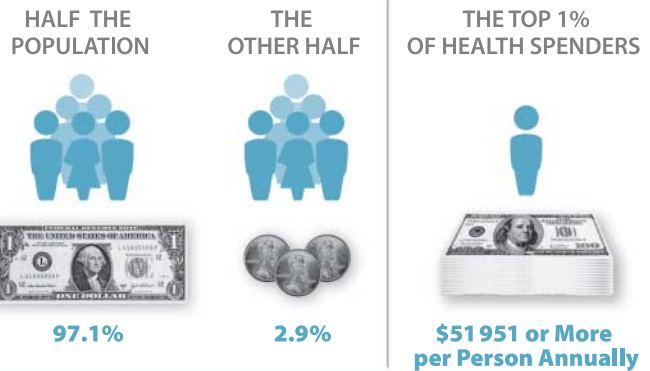


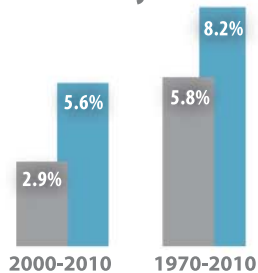

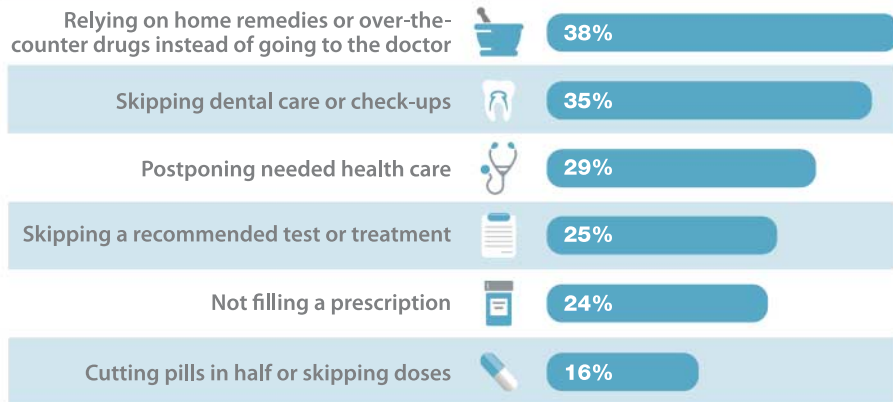
**Health Care Spending per Person Continues to Grow Faster Than the Economy**

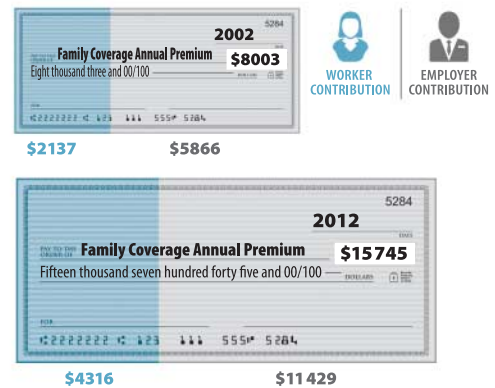
